



On Wednesday, April 18th, from 6:00 to 7:30 p.m., the Ithaca College Department of Education will host an informal book discussion of the text, *Troublemakers: Lessons in Freedom from Young Children at School*.

The book describes the experiences of four children who are described by their teachers as the most challenging children in their classes, and the author asks about the consequences to freedom when children are marginalized for their behaviors in school. The discussion at the Enfield Community Building (182 Enfield Main Road) is open to the public, and a limited number of free copies of the book are available at the Enfield Town Clerk's Office, 168 Enfield Main Road.
