

**AGREEMENT FOR THE EXPENDITURE
OF HIGHWAY MONEYS**

AGREEMENT between the Town Superintendent of the Town of Exfield.
Tompkins County, New York, and the undersigned members of the Town Board.
Pursuant to the provisions of Section 284 of the Highway Law, we agree that moneys levied and collected in the Town for the repair and improvement of highways, and received from the State for State Aid for the repair and improvement of highways, shall be expended as follows:

1. GENERAL REPAIRS. The sum of \$179,469 shall be set aside to be expended for primary work and general repairs upon 86.2 miles of town highways, including sluices, culverts and bridges having a span of less than five feet and boardwalks or the renewals thereof.
2. PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS. The following sums shall be set aside to be expended for the permanent improvement of Town highways:

(a) On the road commencing at HARVEY Hill Rd and leading to Rt 79
a distance of 2.5 miles, there shall be expended not over the sum of \$150,000.

(b) On the road commencing at RATHERMICH and leading to Black Oak Rd.
a distance of 1 miles, there shall be expended not over the sum of \$150,000.
