**WHEREAS**, the TCSWCD has determined its willingness to work cooperatively with the TOWN to accomplish the implementation of the Bostwick Road Stream Stabilization Project

**WHEREAS** The TCSWCD agrees to reimburse the TOWN for up to a total amount not to exceed **\$200,000.00 (two hundred seventeen thousand six hundred dollars)** for expenses incurred related to stream stabilization costs via State funds appropriated to the TCSWCD from the Eastern Finger Lakes Coalition for project implementation; now therefore be it
